

The Cleveland High School Band Parents Association 2019 Buck\$ for Band Cash Raffle (the "Raffle") is a fundraising activity conducted by the Cleveland High School Band Parents Association. (Hereinafter "Cleveland HS BPA") in support of the Cleveland High School Band, located at 1892 Polenta Rd. Clayton, NC 27520, Johnston County. These Official Rules & Regulations govern the conduct of the Raffle and together with the decisions of the Cleveland HS BPA are binding on everyone who purchases a Raffle ticket and/or who is named on a Raffle ticket. It is the responsibility of the ticket purchaser or person named on the Raffle Ticket to review the Official Rules for modification or supplements. These Official Contest Rules may not be waived, modified or supplemented except by the Cleveland HS BPA in writing. No modification of these official contest rules shall be enforceable unless made by the Cleveland HS BPA in writing and approved by the Board. These rules apply to any and all individuals selling Raffle tickets.

The Buck\$ for Band Cash Raffle drawing for the Cleveland HS BPA will be held on Thursday, May 16, 2019 at approximately 7:45pm in the Cleveland High School Auditorium after the Cleveland High School Band Spring Concert.

Tickets may be purchased at the Spring Concert until 7:00 PM EDT, May 16, 2019. Tickets may sell out before that time. The Cleveland HS BPA will conduct drawing in accordance with Raffle rules contained herein. Three (3) cash prizes will be given. The first ticket drawn will determine the winner of a \$500 cash prize. The second ticket drawn will determine the winner of a \$1500 cash prize. The third ticket drawn will determine the winner of a \$3000 cash prize. Each of the three tickets will be drawn at random from a raffle drum containing all eligible Raffle tickets. The drawing for the prize(s) is open to the public; however, the winner does not need to be present to win. Must be at least 18 years old to purchase a ticket.

In order to claim prize, the winner must provide proper identification to the satisfaction of the Cleveland HS BPA and in accordance with the requirements set forth by the State of NC and Federal Government.

TICKETS: The price per one (1) ticket is \$20.00; price for three (3) tickets sold to the same person is \$50. Any ticket(s) may be purchased solely from Cleveland HS BPA. A maximum of 750 tickets will be sold. Ticket sales will cease when the maximum number of qualified entries is reached. If fewer than 450 Raffle tickets are sold, the Cleveland HS BPA reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to convert the raffle to a 50/50 cash raffle. In this situation, 50 % of monies collected from raffle ticket sales will be distributed evenly among three (3) ticket purchasers that are drawn.

All entries must be fully completed in order to be eligible including the printed name, address, phone, number, and email (if available) of the entrant. You have not entered the Raffle until your entry submission, with full payment has been accepted by the Cleveland HS BPA. Acceptance of your entry submission will be communicated to you by delivery of a ticket stub. You may buy as many tickets as you wish, subject to availability, until all 750 are sold. Each Raffle ticket will be entered separately in the drawing.

All sales are final. If for any reason a check payment for a ticket does not clear the bank, the ticket purchase is null and void, the purchaser will be notified immediately of the problem. All fees associated with a return check will be the responsibility of the purchaser.

Cleveland HS BPA does not undertake to give advice on the legal or tax consequences of the Raffle, or its winner(s). However, it understands the the IRS position is that amounts paid for chances in raffles, or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions.

REFUNDS: All Raffle ticket sales are final. No refunds will be made on any tickets sales once ticket is purchased and entry information is completed. Cleveland HS BPA, or their respective directors, officers, contractors, members, committee members, agents, advisors, or representatives be liable to any party for any losses or injuries to earnings, profits or goodwill, or for any incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages of any person or entity.
